On Monday, February 4, 2019, one of our officers initiated a traffic stop in the 1600 block of Watauga Smithfield Road on a 2014 Ford Fusion for expired registration. The vehicle was occupied by a male driver and female passenger. The officer made contact with and identified the driver as David Riley Smith. Mr. Smith showed to have an active warrant his arrest for a parole violation. The female passenger was identified as Shelby Leigh Sanders. Ms. Sanders showed to have an active warrant for her arrest out of Collin County for Fraudulent Destruction, Removal, or Concealment of Writing. Both subjects were arrested and placed into the backseat of the officer's patrol unit. The contracted wrecker service was summoned and a tow inventory of the vehicle was conducted. During the tow inventory, drug paraphernalia was observed in plain sight and a probable cause search of the vehicle was initiated. During the search, our officer found multiple Texas driver's licenses and credit cards belonging to people other than the two occupants of the vehicle. After interviewing the two subjects in custody, it was determined Ms. Sanders obtained the victim's identities while she was working as a tax preparer for Jackson Hewitt in McKinney, Texas in 2018. Some victims have been notified, and we are in the process of notifying the others.
